I wish to make a submission to the Review Group.

- 1. I am unhappy with the make-up of the composition of the Review Group and do not consider it is fair and non biased but in of fin fish aquaculture.
- 2. No fin fish license should be renewed nor issued closer than 30k of a salmon/ sea trout river system
- 3. Each fin fish license should be subject to a public review every 2-3 years so that its effects can be considered in the light of its activities and new scientific information.
- 4. The maximum limit for a fin fish license shall be 10 years and not renewed for that bay / estuary so that the area can be allowed to correct the damage done and to have ownership taken back to the state.
- 5. There must be strong financial penalties put in place where there are breaches of the limited regulations / protocols.
- 6. Where there is new scientific evidence or new data that indicates damage to the marine environment / fish stocks, there should be ability to with draw aquaculture licenses.
- 7. All renewals of former aquaculture licenses must allow public participation even were there is a reduction in the amount of stock in the former license.
