We observed your recently published notice to review the aquaculture licencing process and we welcome such a review as operators need to be able to expand their business in order to meet the demand of Irish produced aquaculture products and thus provide more employment. We know that some businesses have applied for new and renewed licences and the progress has been either extremely slow or non-existent.
